





- 2. These financial results have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standard (Ind-AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 read with rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 and Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Amendment Rules, 2016 to the extent applicable.
- 3. The outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) is causang significant disturbance and slowdown of economic activity in India and across the Globe. The Company has evaluated impact of this pandemic on its business operations. Based on its review and current indicators of economic conditiont there is no significant impact on its financial results and carrying value of Assets, the Company will continue to closely monitor any material changes arising of future economic conditions and impact on its business.
- 4. Ind AS 108 establishes standards for the way that public business enterprises report information about operating segments and related disclosures about geographic areas. The company's operations predominantly relate to enhance business performance. Based on the ""Management Approach"" as defined in Ind AS 108, the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM) evaluates the company's performance and allocates resources based on an analysis of various performance indicators by geographic segments. Accordingly, information has been presented on geographic segments. The accounting principles used in the preparation of the financial statements are consistently applied to record revenue and expenditure in individual segments. Business segments of the company are primarily categorized as: Mumbai and Bhavnagar."
- 5. The Consolidated Financial Statements are prepared in accordance with principles and procedures as set out in the Indian Accounting Standards (""Ind AS 110"") ""Consolidated Financial Statements"" prescribed under section 113 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued there under Consolidated financial statements include financial results of Calvin Divine Enterprise LLP, associates of the company."
- 6. Since the company had published consolidated financial statements for the year ended March 31, 2019 only, corresponding figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2019 have not been presented.
- 7. The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2020 and March 31, 2019 are balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and unaudited year to date figures upto the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 8. The figures of segment results include inter segment interest income/ expense.
- 9. The figures for the corresponding previous year have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary, to make them comparable.

Opinion and Conculsion

We have (a) audited standalone financial results of INDUCTO STEELS LIMITED (the "Company") for the year ended March 31, 2020 and (b) unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter ended March 31, 2020 included in the accompanying Statement of Standalone Financial Results ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").

(a) Opinion on Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2020

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid standalone financial results:

This responsibility includes the preparation and presentation of the Standalone Financial Results for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2020 that give a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations.

Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Standalone Financial Results.
